* Please note: Emails and written comments submitted to the City Council, along with any contact information provided, are considered public records. They may be posted on the City's website and disclosed in accordance with the California Public Records Act.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

During the special meeting, the public may directly address the City Council on any matter that is on the agenda.

Speakers are requested to submit a speaker card prior to the item being called in order to assist with the efficient and orderly conduct of the meeting. A speaker card is not required, provided the speaker makes a clear and timely request to address the Council. Information on speaker cards is subject to public disclosure under the California Public Records Act.

For each item, speaking time is up to three minutes per person, unless otherwise specified for hearings and appeals, or at the discretion of the Mayor or City Council to address special circumstances. The Mayor may modify (increase or decrease) any time requirements for any speaker or change the order of the items on the agenda, in accordance with Council's Rules of Order and Procedures (R2016 6) to facilitate the efficient and fair conduct of the meeting.
