Community Message from the Mayor and the Police Chief regarding Immigration

The City of Woodland and the Woodland Police Department want to address an issue that has understandably raised concerns and questions – immigration and its relationship to public safety within our community. This topic touches the lives of many within Woodland and touches on our shared values of trust, safety, and respect for one another. We believe it is vital to provide clarity about the roles and responsibilities of the City of Woodland and the Woodland Police Department and reaffirm our commitment to serving every member of this community with fairness, dignity, and compassion.

At the Woodland Police Department, we stand by our core values of professionalism, integrity, community relations, and compassionate service. These principles guide our actions, shape our policies, and ensure that we remain a trusted partner in keeping our community safe for everyone who calls it home.

Many in our community may not be aware of California's Values Act (SB 54), also known as the California Sanctuary State law, which outlines the responsibilities of law enforcement agencies regarding immigration. The law ensures that local law enforcement focuses on public safety, not immigration enforcement. Our department does not initiate immigration enforcement actions, inquire about immigration status, or collaborate with federal immigration authorities except as required by law. This approach aligns with our mission to build trust and foster cooperations with all community members, regardless of immigration status.

Everyone in Woodland deserves to feel safe when calling the police for help. Whether you are reporting a crime, seeking assistance, or simply engaging with our officers, you will be treated with respect and compassion. Your safety is our priority, and no one should fear contacting us when in need.

We know trust is built over time, through our actions and the relationships we form. Building trust is essential to keeping our community safe, inclusive, and thriving. We understand that trust begins with listening and showing that we care. Through outreach, dialogue, and collaboration, the City of Woodland and the Woodland Police Department are committed to strengthening our relationship between our department and the people we serve. We are committed to working alongside you to ensure our community is a place where all people feel safe.

Thank you for your trust and partnership. Woodland is a special place because of our diversity, kindness, and resilience. Together, we will continue to make it a safe and welcoming home for all.


