RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, (1) AUTHORIZING THE PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR TO CONDUCT IN-HOUSE PAVING OPERATIONS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY. (2) AND DETERMINING THAT THE ACTIONS AUTHORIZED BY THIS RESOLUTION ARE EXEMPT FROM CEQA

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Napa Section 101 sets the requirements for conducting public works construction and outlines processes for bidding out work; and

WHEREAS, a first list of streets for Citywide Paving Services (“Project”) was posted on the public board outside City Hall near the Council Chamber door continuously for 5 days from February 3 to February 7 with sealed bids due on February 7, 2025; and

WHEREAS, a second list of streets for Citywide Paving Services (“Project”) was posted on the public board outside City Hall near the Council Chamber door continuously for more than 5 days from February 11 to February 18 with sealed bids due on February 18, 2025; and

WHEREAS, streets included in the Project scopes of work include Garfield Lane, Valle Verde Dr., Industrial Way, Byway East (Salvador St. to Wise Dr.), Redwood Road (Solano Ave. to train tracks), Shetler Ave. (Soscol Ave. to Wilkins Ave.), Jefferson St. (Lincoln to Clay Ave.), Yajome St. (Lincoln Ave. to Central Ave.), Central Ave. (Yajome St. to Jefferson St.), Arden Way, Harold Ct., Easley Ct., Maher St. (Las Flores to Trower Ave.), Linda Vista Ave. (Trower Ave. to Las Flores Dr.), Larkin Way, Pinewood Dr. (Skycrest Way to Scenic Dr.), Abbey Ct., Stratford Ct., Lynn Dr., Morlan, Jefferson St. (Salvador Ave. to El Centro Ave.), Villa Lane (Trancas to Pear Tree Lane), Beecham St., Third St. (Wilson to Coombs St.), Franklin St. (Elm St. to Spruce St.), and Walnut Street; and

WHEREAS, No (0) bids were received on February 7, 2025 for the Project; and

WHEREAS, No (0) bids were received on February 18th, 2025 for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council may authorize the Project work to be undertaken by the appropriate department per the City Charter in the case no bids are received or in the case bids are deemed excessive; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered all information related to this matter, as presented at the public meetings of the City Council identified herein, including any supporting reports by City Staff, and any information provided during public meetings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Napa, as follows:

ATTACHMENT 1

1. The City Council hereby finds that the facts set forth in the recitals to this Resolution are true and correct and establish the factual basis for the City Council's adoption of this Resolution.

2. The City Council hereby determines that the actions authorized by this Resolution are exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15301(c), which exempts the repair or minor alteration of existing streets, sidewalks, gutters, and similar facilities.

3. The City Council hereby authorizes the Public Works Director to conduct the Project construction to pave City streets listed herein through in-house paving operations with City resources, including but not limited to City employee labor, City equipment, and material and service contracts, on behalf of the City.

4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
