

RESOLUTION R2025-XX

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE POLICE CHIEF TO ENTER INTO A LICENSING AGREEMENT WITH THE CALIFORNIA HIGHWAY PATROL FOR THE USE OF THE CITY SHOOTING RANGE THROUGH 12/31/2025 AND DETERMINING THAT THE ACTIONS AUTHORIZED BY THIS RESOLUTION ARE EXEMPT FROM CEQA.

WHEREAS, the Police Department operates and maintains a firearms training facility (“City Shooting Range”) for conducting and maintaining required training for police officers; and

WHEREAS, members of the Napa office of the California Highway Patrol (“CHP”) have used the City Shooting Range for more than twenty years to conduct and maintain required training standards; and

WHEREAS, the CHP has requested to enter into a license agreement for the use of the City Shooting Range through 12/31/2025 for \$2,000.00 per month; and

WHEREAS, the CHP requires this license agreement to be approved by a resolution by this City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered all information related to this matter, as presented at the public meetings of the City Council identified herein, including any supporting reports by City Staff, and any information provided during public meetings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Napa, as follows:

1. The City Council hereby finds that the facts set forth in the recitals to this Resolution are true and correct and establish the factual basis for the City Council’s adoption of this Resolution.
2. The City Council hereby approves and authorizes the Police Chief to enter into a license agreement with CHP for the use of the City Shooting Range through 12/31/2025.
3. The City Council hereby determines that the actions authorized by this Resolution are exempt from CEQA, pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15060(c), which exempts projects that do not physically damage the environment. In the alternative, and on a separate and independent basis, the Recommended Action is exempt from environmental review pursuant to CEQA Guideline 15301

as the licensing of an existing facility involving no expansion, or a negligible expansion, of use.

4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
