PROCLAMATION**

***Parks and Recreation Month
July 2026***

WHEREAS, parks and recreation services are an essential part of communities, and our parks and recreation services for the City of Napa are vitally important to establishing and maintaining positive public health standards, and contributing to the economic and environmental well-being of our community and region; and

WHEREAS, parks and recreation services are fundamental to the development of community by fostering social ties and community identity, enhancing quality of life, supporting healthy communities, and improving the mental and emotional well-being of all citizens; and

WHEREAS, City Council has identified “Parks & Community Spaces” as one of its six current Focus Areas, which is intended to drive targeted progress toward improving and expanding local parks and recreational facilities; and

WHEREAS, Measure G established a dedicated local sales tax to fund essential services and critical infrastructure, advancing over \$10 million in key park projects and programs over the two-year budget cycle, and supporting the landmark acquisition of the Harvest Middle School property to address recreation facility gaps for local residents; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. House of Representatives has designated July as Parks and Recreation Month; and the City of Napa recognizes the benefits derived from parks and recreation services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that I, Scott Sedgley, Mayor of the City of Napa, along with the Napa City Council, do hereby proclaim ***July 2026 as Parks and Recreation Month*** in the City of Napa.
