ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
NAPA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, AMENDING NAPA  
MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 2.08.090 REGARDING THE  
DESIGNATION OF A DEPUTY CITY MANAGER POSITION  
AS AN APPOINTIVE OFFICER EMPLOYEE IN THE CITY  
MANAGER'S OFFICE

WHEREAS, there is a need to update the provisions of the Napa Municipal Code related to the identification of "appointive officer" positions within the City Manager's Office, as defined by City Charter Section 75, in order to add the second of two deputy city manager positions as appointive officers (all other appointive officer positions in the City Manager's Office remain, including: one assistant city manager, one community relations and media manager, and one secretary to the city manager); and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered all information related to this matter, as presented at the public meeting of the City Council identified herein, including any supporting reports by City staff, and any information provided during public meetings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Napa as follows:

**SECTION 1:** Amendment. Napa Municipal Code Section 2.08.090 is hereby amended by repealing the previous Subsection 2.08.090(A), and adopting language to read as set forth below [NOTE: only Subsection 2.08.090(A) is amended by this ordinance; and Subsections 2.08.090(B), (C), (D), and (E) are not amended by this ordinance]:

- A. Designation of appointive officers. The City Council hereby designates the following appointive officers pursuant to Section 75 of the charter:
1. One assistant city manager.
  2. Two deputy city managers.
  3. One community relations and media manager.
  4. One secretary to the city manager.

**SECTION 2:** Severability. If any section, sub-section, subdivision, paragraph, clause or phrase in this Ordinance, or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections or portions of this Ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed each section, sub-section, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, sub-sections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases may be declared

invalid or unconstitutional.

**SECTION 3:** Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days following adoption.
