RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, APROVING THE 2019 ANNUAL FIRE INSPECTION COMPLIANCE REPORT PREPARED PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE SECTIONS 13146.2 – 13146.4 (SB 1205)

WHEREAS, California state law requires that all fire departments and districts in the state conduct annual safety inspections, as set forth in California Health and Safety Code Sections 13146.2 and 13146.3; and

WHEREAS, the Napa Fire Department conducted annual safety inspections for 2019, as summarized in the 2019 Annual Fire Inspection Compliance Report, attached as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, California Senate Bill No. 1205 (Hill) was enacted in January 2019, requiring all fire departments to submit annual reports to their governing bodies regarding their compliance with these state mandated fire inspections, as set forth in California Health and Safety Code Section 13146.4; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered all information related to this matter, as presented at the public meetings of the City Council identified herein, including any supporting reports by City Staff, and any information provided during public meetings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Napa, as follows:

- 1. The City Council hereby finds that the facts set forth in the recitals to this Resolution are true and correct, and establish the factual basis for the City Council's adoption of this Resolution.
- 2. The City Council hereby acknowledges receipt of the 2019 Annual Fire Inspection Compliance Report (attached hereto as Exhibit "A," and incorporated herein by reference) in accordance with California Health and Safety Code Section 13146.4.
- 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
