We will need to provide people at the Senior Center with Covid 19 virus factual information and recommended health precautions as part of our comprehensive service to the senior community. The renovation of the beautiful, new Senior Center is an opportunity to have our Senior Center transition into a community "hub" for events, classes, artistic opportunities, workshops and important senior information and resource exchanges. I would like to see our Senior Center expand our program selection to include community health (now Covid 19) and disaster safety workshops, designed specifically for senior preparedness.. I would like to see the Senior Center be the place that elected official and representatives of other agencies want to hold a seminar about senior issues because the Senior Center is their most attractive and populated choice.

How would you approach improving these project(s) or program(s)?


As Commissioners, we will need to support and offer assistance to the staff in supporting any Covid 19 related procedures and precautions that are developed at the Senior Center. The Commissioners could be scheduled to serve as Good Will Monitors in reminding people about face coverings and social distancing. I would want to continue to help actualize some of the goals we developed in the Strategic Plan for the newly remodeled Senor Center. We have discussed more community publicity through the Market Place Magazine and Napa Register and pictures in Faces and Places to attract both new seniors and younger aged seniors. We could also put articles in the agency newsletters of those serving seniors. It may also be beneficial to have attractive flyers that could be distributed through Napa Community Housing senior facilities, Meals on Wheels, Molly's Angels, and Health and Human Services. Perhaps we could develop a Welcoming Committee of volunteers, including some commissioners, who would make sure everyone feels welcome and offer a personal, friendly contact. Commissioners are eager to volunteer and they could be used more as a resource for support staff. They could assist staff by making phone calls; during disasters/pandemic or routine follow up calls. Commissioners could also act as table hosts and for special luncheons. I would also suggest that the newly remodeled Senior Center be showcased as a SIGNIFICANT PLUS for choosing to live in the City of Napa during the 55+ senior years on through retirement.
