RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF NAPA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA APPROVING UPDATED SECTION 8 HOUSING CHOICE VOUCHER PROGRAM PAYMENT STANDARDS

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires housing authorities to review their Payment Standards to ensure they are within 90% to 110% of the new Fair Market Rents; and

WHEREAS, Resolution HR2020-001 adopted payment standards effective April 1, 2020 for the Housing Authority of the City of Napa (hereafter the "Authority"); and

WHEREAS, the existing payment standards remain in effect until the new payment standards set forth herein are implemented on April 1, 2021; and

WHEREAS, rents are continuing to increase in the local rental market, making it difficult for Section 8 participants to locate suitable rental units; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has determined that there is a need to modify the payment standards to maintain affordability for existing families and to increase the number of rental units available to Section 8 participants; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has considered all information related to this matter including any supporting reports by Housing Authority staff.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the Housing Authority of the City of Napa, as follows:

- 1. The Authority Board finds that the facts set forth in the recitals to this Resolution are true and correct and establish the factual basis for the Authority's adoption of this Resolution.
- 2. The Authority Board hereby approves the following as the Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher Program Payment Standards which shall become effective April 1, 2021; \$1,331 for zero-bedroom units, \$1,546 for one-bedroom units, \$2,038 for two-bedroom units, \$2,854 for three-bedroom units, \$2,886 for four-bedroom units, \$3,319 for five-bedroom units, and \$3,724 for six bedroom units.
 - 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
