National Bike Month May 2021 and Bike to Wherever Day May 21, 2021

WHEREAS, May is “National Bike Month” and Friday, May 21, 2021 is “Bike to Wherever Day” throughout the San Francisco Bay Area; and

WHEREAS, the City of Napa Bicycle Plan identifies as a goal of the Plan to increase the mode share of bicycling; and

WHEREAS, bicycle transportation is an integral part of the multi-modal transportation system planned for by federal, state, regional and local government agencies; and

WHEREAS, bicycle commuting benefits both employees and employers through better employee health and fitness, reduced health care costs, traffic congestion and parking; and

WHEREAS, switching some short trips from driving to biking can save money by reducing costs related to gas, maintenance, and depreciation; and
