TITLE:

Designation of Certifying Officer for the National Environmental Policy Act

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

Adopt a resolution designating the Community Development Director as the "Certifying Officer" as defined in 24 C.F.R. Part 58 for the City of Napa for purposes of compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act

DISCUSSION:

The City receives federal funding from the United States government, including funds from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). This includes the City's annual allocation of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds. HUD requires recipients of these federal funds to assume responsibility for conducting environmental reviews for projects and programs in accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA). In assuming HUD's responsibilities under NEPA, HUD requires each jurisdiction to designate an individual to carry out the responsibilities of "certifying officer" as defined in 24 C.F.R. Part 58. Because these environmental reviews are typically completed by the Community Development Department, staff recommends designating the Community Development Director to serve as the City's Certifying Officer.
