RECOMMENDED ACTION:

DISCUSSION:

Three Girl Scouts from Troops 20050 and 20056, Marianne Homer, Isabela Tibbits and Donna Roscoe earned the Gold Award on May 20, 2018. The Gold Award is the highest achievement within the Girl Scouts. It is the most difficult to attain, with a seven-step service project requirement.
