RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA (1) ACCEPTING THE CANNABIS TAX FUND PROGRAM GRANT FROM THE CALIFORNIA HIGHWAY PATROL IN THE AMOUNT OF \$261,810.58; (2) AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO EXECUTE THE GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE CALIFORNIA HIGHWAY PATROL; (3) APPROVING REVENUE AND EXPENDITURE BUDGET INCREASES OF \$261,810.58 IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S SPECIAL REVENUE GRANTS FUND FOR THE CHP CANNABIS TAX FUND GRANT PROGRAM FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026-2027 AS DOCUMENTED IN BUDGET AMENDMENT NO.3P2, (4) DETERMINING THAT THE ACTIONS AUTHORIZED BY THIS RESOLUTION ARE EXEMPT FROM CEQA PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINE 15060(c)

WHEREAS, the Napa Police Department, in an effort to reduce and mitigate the impacts of impaired driving in the City of Napa applied for a grant from the California Highway Patrol (CHP), Cannabis Tax Fund Grant Program (CTFGP); and

WHEREAS, the Napa Police Department was awarded the CTFGP grant totaling \$261,810.58; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered all information related to this matter, as presented at the public meetings of the City Council identified herein, including any supporting reports by City Staff, and any information provided during public meetings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Napa, as follows:

1. The City Council hereby finds that the facts set forth in the recitals to this Resolution are true and correct and establish the factual basis for the City Council's adoption of this Resolution.
2. The City Council hereby accepts the CHP Grant in the amount of \$261,810.58 for the CTFGP and authorizes the Chief of Police to execute the CTFGP Grant Agreement on behalf of the City, attached hereto as Exhibit A.
3. The City Council hereby approves the budget adjustment in the Police Department's Grants Fund for Fiscal Year 2026-2027 increasing both the revenue and expenditure budgets by \$261,810.58 as documented in Council Budget Amendment No.3P2 attached hereto as Exhibit A.
