Recognizing June 2025 as Pride Month

- *WHEREAS*, Pride Month is about celebrating the LGBTQ+ community, recognizing their history and advocating for their rights and inclusion. It's a time to raise awareness about issues facing the community and to promote understanding and acceptance; and
- WHEREAS, the tireless dedication of advocates and allies has led to increased support for LGBTQ+ rights. Celebrating Pride Month as a community also promotes awareness and visibility, fosters dialogue, strengthens alliances, builds acceptance, and advances equal rights for LGBTQ+ individuals; and
- WHEREAS, the theme for Napa Pride 2025, "Celebrate in Solidarity | Celebrar en Solidaridad," standing as a beacon of joy, belonging, and resistance. Pride is not just a celebration – it's a bold act of visibility. These events create opportunities for connection and care, bringing together LGBTQ+ people and allies to stand up and show up, together; and
- *WHEREAS*, the City of Napa supports continued efforts to create inclusive environments – free from discrimination and prejudice – which are essential to ensuring that LGBTQ+ people are treated with dignity and respect in all areas of life, including education, employment, healthcare, and public service.
