What is your understanding of the role and responsibility of this board?

Public Art Steering Committee From what I understand, this committee helps guide the City Council and city staff on decisions about public art. That includes reviewing proposals that come through in-lieu contributions and weighing in on the city's Public Art Master Plan when updates are needed. At its core, the role is about making sure the art we bring into public spaces reflects the character of the community and adds to the cultural life of the city. Parks, Recreation and Trees Advisory Commission This commission advises both City Council and the Parks and Recreation Services Director on how the city develops, maintains, and improves parks, recreation programs, and cultural activities. It also plays an important part in shaping policies related to trees and landscaped areas, both public and private. Beyond advising, the commission has decision-making responsibility in certain cases, like appeals around planting or removing city trees, or permits involving significant and protected trees. To me, this role is about stewardship... making thoughtful decisions that balance community use, natural resources, and long-term sustainability.

Public Art Steering Committee What interests me most is the chance to help shape how art shows up in public spaces. I like the idea of reviewing proposals and thinking about how they connect to the character of the community. I'm also drawn to the responsibility of keeping the Public Art Master Plan relevant over time, making sure it continues to reflect the city's values and aspirations. Parks, Recreation and Trees Advisory Commission The part that interests me most is the mix of stewardship and long-term planning. I care a lot about how parks and public spaces are designed and maintained, and I'm equally interested in how tree policies and preservation efforts shape the future of the city. The commission's role in appeals and tree-related decisions also stands out to me, because it balances practical needs with protecting the natural environment, something I've always cared about.

What activities of this board are least interesting to you?

Public Art Steering Committee There aren't duties I'd call uninteresting, but the more administrative parts of reviewing process details or funding mechanics are less engaging to me than the creative side. I'm most energized by discussions about vision, community impact, and how art can shape public space. Parks, Recreation and Trees Advisory Commission For me, the least interesting pieces are the procedural aspects... things like handling appeals or working through technical ordinance details. I see the value in that work and would take it seriously, but what excites me more is the bigger-picture role of helping guide how parks, recreation, and trees contribute to the community's quality of life.

What programs or projects would you like to see improved or implemented?

Public Art Steering Committee I'd love to see more opportunities for local artists to be represented in public spaces, with a real focus on diversity of voices, styles, and mediums. Public art shouldn't just be concentrated downtown or in parks... it could be spread throughout neighborhoods, along trails, and in unexpected places where it can surprise and inspire people in their daily lives. Parks, Recreation and Trees Advisory Commission I'm a strong believer in the ecological and cultural value of native plants, and I'd like to see them included more intentionally in city projects and landscapes. I'm also excited by the progress being made on bike trails, and I'd love to see more public spaces designed to connect those trails with pedestrian pathways. It's a way to create healthier, more accessible, and more sustainable connections across the community.

How would you approach improving these project(s) or program(s)?

Public Art Steering Committee I'd approach improving public art programs by listening first-gathering input from a broader range of community members, especially voices that don't always show up in public forums. My background in user experience research has taught me how to design ways for people to share honest feedback, whether through workshops, interviews, or simple surveys. I'd use those skills to make public comment more accessible and to translate what we hear into clear priorities for new projects. That way, the art we bring into Napa reflects the diversity of people who live here. Parks, Recreation and Trees Advisory Commission For parks and tree programs, I'd take a similar approach: using research and engagement tools to hear directly from residents about how they use public spaces, what they value most, and where they see gaps. My experience leading crossfunctional design work has shown me how to turn community input into practical, actionable plans. I'd focus on creating opportunities for people to weigh in beyond the usual public meetings, making engagement more inclusive and helping the commission ground its decisions in real community needs.
